

## ABOUT CHRIS REISMAN



Chris Reisman was named the 14th head men's basketball coach in Tarleton history on March 23, 2018 after his father, Lonn Reisman, stepped down after 30 years as head coach of the Texans to move to full-time athletic director.

Reisman has spent the last 12 years as the director of recruiting, scouting, academic counseling and individual development in addition to on-the-floor coaching and assisting in the day-to-day operations.

Reisman, who completed a four-year playing career for the Texans in 2001, has helped the team to a 461-189 (70.9 percent) record in his 20 years with the program as

a player and a coach.

As a coach alone, Reisman has helped direct a 395-113 (77.7 percent) record his first 16 years on the coaching staff. Moreover, the Texans competed in five straight NCAA Tournaments (2002-06) and have won a Lone Star Conference record four South Central regional tournaments, including back-to-back Elite Eights in 2005 and 2006 and 2015 and 2016. Tarleton reached the Final Four in 2005 and 2015. In addition to being a part of all 14 of Tarleton's NCAA playoff berths, Chris has helped develop six DII All-Americans in Danny Jones, Tim Burnette, David Stephens, John Davis, Chuck Guy and Romond Jenkins.

From 2010-12, Tarleton stifled opposing offenses and was recognized as the No. 1 defense in the nation in back-to-back seasons, including the Division I, III and Junior College levels, an honor that the younger Reisman is proud of. Tarleton added its third statistical championship of the Chris Reisman coaching era in 2013-14 when the Texans topped the nation in scoring margin.

The son of head coach Lonn Reisman, Chris started 34 games in his last two seasons and finished his career ranked sixth on Tarleton's all-time assists chart with 281. Reisman led the LSC as a senior in 2001 with 6.08 assists and topped the league as a junior in 2000 with a 2.33 assist-to-turnover ratio. He played in all 29 games as a sophomore in 1999, helping the Texans to the Lone Star Conference championship game.

Reisman served on the LSC Commissioners Honor Roll as well as the secretary of the Tarleton established "Athletes Committed to Education" (ACE) organization. For three years, Reisman served on the Student Athletic Advisory Council at Tarleton.

Born in Jonesboro, Ark., Chris graduated from Stephenville High School in 1997. He was a three-year basketball letterman for the Yellow Jackets, earning first team all-district and all-region honors. He led his senior team to the area finals, the furthest it had been in over 30 years.

## SUPERVISION

Tarleton State University basketball staff, college coaches, high school coaches and college players will make up the camp staff.

## INDIVIDUAL INSTRUCTION

The camp provides instruction in all basketball fundamentals including shooting, ball handling, scoring situations, defense and rebounding. Campers will compete against players in their own age group.

## WHAT TO BRING

Campers will be required to furnish their own toiletries, bedding supplies, alarm clock, plus athletic equipment as follows: 5 T-shirts, 5 pair of playing shorts, 1 pair of basketball shoes, 5 pair of athletic socks and one sweatshirt. Also campers will want a swimsuit and casual clothing for free time.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

### REGISTRATION:

Fill out and return the attached application form. The camp fee for the Tarleton Elite Camp is \$325 and includes room and board, insurance and a souvenir T-shirt and basketball. **An advance registration deposit of \$100.00 must accompany each application and will not be refunded.** The balance of \$225.00 is due at the time of registration. The cost for commuters will be \$150.

You will be notified if your application cannot be accepted. **There WILL BE NO REFUNDS FOR ANY REASON AFTER A CHILD HAS BEEN ACCEPTED AND IS IN THE CAMP.** Please make all checks payable to *Texan Basketball Camp*.

1. 2. I acknowledge there may be physically strenuous activities. 3. NO INSURANCE: I understand that RELEASEES do not maintain any insurance policy covering any circumstance arising from my participation in this activity or any event related to that participation. As such, I am aware that I should review my personal insurance coverage. Sponsor does not carry general liability insurance to cover claims arising from this activity so it seeks a waiver of claims as additional consideration for the right to participate so sponsor, a governmental unit of the State of Texas, can (a) provide the activity at the lowest possible cost to participants; and (b) provide access to a greater number of participants by expending limited resources on program materials rather than on liability insurance.

4. BINDS HEIRS: It is my express intent that this agreement shall bind the members of my family and spouse, if I am alive and my heirs, assigns and personal representatives, if I am deceased, and shall be governed by the laws of the State of Texas.

5. MEDICAL AUTHORIZATION, INDEMNITY FOR MEDICAL EXPENSES, and WAIVER: I understand RELEASEES cannot be expected to control all of the risks associated with this activity and RELEASEES may need to respond to accidents and potential emergency situations. I agree to indemnify and hold harmless INDEMNITIEES for any costs incurred to treat me, even if an INDEMNITEE has signed hospital documentation promising to pay for the treatment due to my inability to sign the documentation. I exclude this document, or full, adequate and complete consideration, fully intending to be bound by the same, now and in the future. **For students engaging in extracurricular activities:** I understand I can choose not to sign this document and free myself from its terms and the associated risks of the activity by simply not participating in the activity and choosing some other activity available to me that has a lower level of risk to me. I further understand this is a voluntary, extracurricular activity, therefore it is not required for me to obtain college credits and not participating in this activity will in no way hinder my ability to obtain a degree from the university. **For students going on fieldtrips or other class-related activities:** I understand participation in this class/fieldtrip/activity is not mandatory and I will not be penalized for failing to participate in this activity because an alternative activity exists for which I can receive like credit.
